



## ARLINGTON HISTORIC RESOURCES SURVEY UPDATE

Under the auspices of the City of Arlington Community Services Department and the Arlington Landmark Preservation Commission, HHM conducted a multi-phase historic resources survey within the current City of Arlington boundaries. The first phase of the project documented and re-evaluated all properties that were previously identified in the City of Arlington Historic Resources Survey, completed by HHM in 1987. The survey team also surveyed all resources, regardless of date of construction, located within the boundaries of the city's two existing NRHP historic districts. During phase two, HHM documented and assessed all pre-1945 resources that had not been identified during the 1987 survey. The final phase of the project was a reconnaissance-level documentation of all subdivisions/additions platted between 1945 and 1960 within the city limits. To efficiently evaluate the nearly 10,000 resources constructed between 1945 and 1950, HHM developed a programmatic approach that examines architectural typologies and patterns of development of neighborhoods from this period in order to identify potential historic districts. HHM architectural historians and historians also conducted archival research in order to prepare a historic context. The historic context facilitated the assessment of the surveyed postwar subdivisions by identifying development patterns and influential growth factors within the city.

In addition to the written report and photographic documentation of each surveyed resource, HHM submitted to the City of Arlington GIS maps and data. The database developed by HHM was compatible with the City's existing GIS system and is a key management tool for its preservation planning program.
