## RECREATIONAL RESIDENCE HISTORICAL CONTEXT FOR EIGHT NATIONAL FORESTS IN USDA-REGION 1, MONTANA AND IDAHO



HHM undertook a historic context study for the United States Department of Agriculture Forest Service, Lewis and Clark National Forest. HHM was tasked with preparing an overall historic context addressing the history of recreation and the development of recreational residences on Forest Service lands in Region 1. In addition, HHM developed eight individual historic contexts for each national forest in the region. The overall and individual contexts aid in future eligibility

evaluations for the National Register of Historic Places. HHM also prepared registration requirements for the historic resources as well as additional planning tools. This project is relevant to the proposal as it demonstrates the firm's experience in preparing overall historic contexts that aid cultural resource investigations as well as the firm's experience in the western region of the United States.
